Greetings from the Parsonage!

June promises to be a busy month for us in the parish. I am not sure how that happened but so it did. The nice thing about sitting between two small cities (Yes, I consider Ellsworth a small city—it has two pizza places after all!) is that you can take part in what goes on in each one. With our fellow congregations in Ellsworth, we will be joining together for VBS in early June. I would encourage everyone who has a child in their life to enroll them immediately! In an ever-changing and challenging world—especially for children—it is so important to establish a relationship with Jesus as early as we can. We would not wait to throw a life preserver to a man overboard nor deny water to someone who thirsts on a hot day—why then do we often deny the Giver of Life itself?

With our fellow congregations in Red Wing, we will be joining together for "Church Everywhere!" This is a brief (20ish minutes) Wednesday night service (6:00 pm) that rotates locations but is never in a church building. Do not fear, the service will be done before Music in Central Park begins. This parish will host a service later in the summer—more on that in August. The idea is to connect the Christians of the Mississippi River valley and create an opportunity to invite non- or inactive Christians to worship outside of the Church building. My senior thesis was on the historical development of church architecture—I love our two sanctuaries but I know that some people aren't comfortable worshipping in them. Our hope is to serve people where they are, not necessarily where we want them to be. A different Red Wing Area pastor will preach each week and provide communion—cookies will be served afterward. (That last part one me over!) The first service will be on June 5, 6:00 pm, behind the Goodhue County Historical Society.

On June 23, we will have our Midsummer Service in the Parsonage Grove at Svea. I dressed as a Swede last year; I am thinking of going as a Norwegian this year. A group of Hardanger Fiddle players will be offering special music during this service. This is the national instrument of Norway and has a sound that you can't forget. Following the service, we will have a picnic. Midsummer is a traditional Scandinavian festival and honors the birth of John the Baptist—it is also six months to Christmas. The kids at Eidsvold always have me pray for the weather, I ask you to do the same—pray for no rain. Violins cannot get wet and picnics are better outside. If anyone has a Scandinavian costume, I would encourage you to wear it—I'll be in mine.

Lastly, on June 30, we will hold the Mark Drama! This is an acted-out version of the Gospel of Mark which runs about an hour and a half. I am glad to announce that we have found a location to host the Drama—in the banquet hall at *The Bluff's*. This is another way to invite someone you know to come to experience the Gospel. If you have not already, please sign up to participate—there are nonspeaking roles for those just looking for the experience. I have the most fun when I take a chance and try something completely new. The sign-up sheet is in the back of both sanctuaries—otherwise, give me a call or text me at (608)799-9703.

Uff Da! Is that enough for one month? Even if you can only make one of these events—it will be a blessing to have you there. Pastor Al



June 7-8 Synod Assembly







Summer Women's Bible Study
