Greetings from the Pastor!

As the weather changes and we find ourselves increasingly inside, avoiding the cold—our parish has a wonderful opportunity to make the most of this time. The Red Wing Area churches have produced another set of Loop Group videos! This is the third Loop series that our parish has contributed to.

Loop videos are 10-minute devotionals that deal with an overall theme—this new six-part series addresses "change." The hope is that folks with gather in small groups, watch the video, and then discuss it. Each video comes with a discussion guide but groups should not feel limited by those questions.

Since life can be hectic, Loop Groups are encouraged to set their own meeting schedule. The videos and discussion guides are posted on YouTube and will be shared on our Facebook page each week. The goal with Loops is to build small communities within the larger community. Loops are intended to meet in homes but any place where people are able to connect is great. In Red Wing, Loops have met over Zoom, at a Care Center, the Library, and at the churches.

The series on change runs 10 minutes each, but past videos have run about 25 minutes and include a musical offering, a perspective from a parishioner as well as from a pastor. These older series can be found on the YouTube page as well. If you are unable to join a Loop Group, I encourage you to watch the videos with a family member or friend and discuss as you would in a larger group.
