Our program year begins again on September 8! If you have been away for the summer or just a few days, I hope to see you on Rally Sunday.

As I said in my August newsletter article, we are looking for your event and ministry ideas. There is now a box in the back of each sanctuary for you to drop the parish a note. I take these ideas very seriously and have been following up on them as best as I can. I plan to collect the suggestions, type them up, and hang them in the back of our two sanctuaries. The hope is that, through conversation, interest may grow around a few of them. We are large enough as a parish to be a formidable force in this community—and we have a mandate from God to be so. "And Jesus answered them, 'Truly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' it will happen."

As individuals, it is easy to look at the problems of the world and be completely overwhelmed by them. We can think, "Well what can I do about that!? The problem is just too big!" It is true, our society and in fact our entire globe is plagued with the shadowy effects of Sin. Forces that come to disrupt our lives and our faith in Christ Jesus appear as disease, famine, war, hatred, division, greed, lust, but all stem from the Sin that entered our reality at Creation's Fall. I say this—not to rub it in—but to acknowledge the daunting task facing us. But I tell you that we are not meant to face the task alone. We are called into communities of faith so we might look at Sin and think, "Well together, we can do something about it! Together with and by God's Strength and Wisdom, we can do battle against the foe that challenges us. Have faith in the God that calls us into dark places, have faith that the Light He shines through us can never be overcome by Sin. Have faith to speak the words that God whispers to you—the urges He places in your heart to act—for in a community of faith, you may be surprised to whom He speaks the same words.
